Terms & conditions

1. Cambridge Wedding Video, SB Multimedia Productions, and The SB Group are trading names of Stuart Braybrooke.
2. Video's are produced to good commercial standards using modern digital technology. Video's are not intended for broadcast. DVD's are produced on DVD-R with MPEGII video at variable bit rates of up to 6000 kbs.
3. The aesthetics used in a video are in keeping with typical English weddings and will be similar to the demonstration video available from Cambridge Wedding Video. Artistic interpretation cannot be guaranteed.
4. Unless otherwise agreed all filming uses a single camera. A second camera is often used for creative purposes but this is at the discretion of the producer.
5. Additional audio recording may be used where appropriate at the discretion of Cambridge Wedding Video and by agreement with the church or registrar.
6. We aim to be discreet whilst filming but in low light conditions additional camera-mounted lighting may be required. We will minimise the use of external artificial light as much as possible.
7. Copyright clearance for any stills submitted to Cambridge Wedding Video for scanning is the responsibility of the submitter.
8. Copyright clearance for any music used in the service or submitted to Cambridge Wedding Video for inclusion in the video is the responsibility of the client. Please visit www.videolicence.co.uk for full details.
9. Fees paid for the Cambridge Wedding Video service are for time taken to plan with the couple, filming on the day, and editing the film in the studio. Any equipment used in production is "free-issued" for the duration of the event and is loaned without any acceptance for liability or consequential loss. Any media offered for delivery in the price is effectively "free" and carries no warranty.
10. A date may only be considered reserved once a completed booking form has been received and the deposit has been cashed by Stuart Braybrooke. Until that point dates cannot be guaranteed. Any deposit received for a date which is no longer available will be returned to the sender with no further liability on either party.
11. Weddings sometimes need to be cancelled. We strongly recommend that all couples take out comprehensive wedding insurance to protect themselves from costs if they have to cancel. Cancellation charges are as follows; more than 90 days prior to the date = deposit only, 90 days to 30 days prior to the date = deposit plus half the remaining cost, less than 30 days prior to the date = full amount.
12. Final payment is required in full before completed material and media are released.
13. We use good quality and well maintained equipment. However, any loss of material or software (i.e. video and/or audio of the event) is limited to the cost of the media alone. No consequential loss is accepted by Cambridge Wedding Video or Stuart Braybrooke.
14. Any variations in the times or dates, or variations to the planned event which may impact the video work should be communicated to Cambridge Wedding Video as soon as possible. Depending on the changes there may be additional charges which will be advised before any variation is agreed or accepted.
15. We keep a master copy of your movie in our archives for up to 1 year. You may order additional copies within this period as required. If you wish to order additional copies after 1 year we cannot guarantee that the master will be available.
16. These terms and conditions should be attached to your booking form and kept in a safe place, They form part of your contract.
